Identifying Characteristics

She has scarring on her abdomen from several surgeries, pierced ears, a mole on the back of her neck, a rose tattoo on her upper breast area and a tattoo of a skunk on her hip. She was last seen wearing a pair of grey stretchy pants, a black and white shirt, a white coat, and black shoes with a stacked heel. She suffers from depression and had recovered from colon cancer the summer prior to her disappearance.

Circumstances

Victoria was last seen at her residence in the Township of Pittsfield on 4-25-13 at about 10:00 P.M. She was discovered missing on 4-26-13 about 4:00 A.M. She left behind her purse with all of its contents to include her ID, money, as well as her cell phone and cigarettes. She has no known credit cards and no vehicle. Search and Rescue teams using dogs, horses, and divers have not found any trace of Vicki. Early reports pointed to her depression as the cause of her disappearance, but in May of 2015, investigators found evidence of blood at her home along with other items that point to possible abduction or homicide.
